

GARBAGE COLLECTION RULES

All refuse and garbage must be in proper containers for collection. Household refuse shall be in metal or plastic containers with a capacity of not more than 32 gallons and weighing no more than 65 pounds, with tight-fitting lids, and lined with trash bags. Dumpsters may be used for apartment houses, and for commercial and industrial collection. Also, no grease shall be placed within any container.

All Household refuse and garbage must be placed at the curbside of the nearest public roadway for collection by 7:00 a.m. on each scheduled collection day. Businesses will place their refuse containers at the rear or side of the establishments in such a manner that they will be readily accessible for collection.

If there is no truck lift dumpster in place, then the Business or Industry must obtain one if needed. If a truck lift dumpster is already in place but not large enough to accommodate the refuse and garbage generated, then the Business or Industry must obtain an additional or larger one, or request additional collection(s) at a fee established by the Town.

Any truck lift dumpster or other holding facility which is blocked by parked cars, machinery, etc. on a scheduled collection day will be left until the following scheduled collection day. OSHA requires a three-foot clearance around all dumpsters at all times.

There will be no charge for one (1) load per month for special trips to haul brush, tires, cans, and all other types of rubbish which must be hauled in a dump truck. Additional loads may be picked up at \$25.00 per hour. This is not considered to be a part of the regular refuse and garbage collection. These collections are done on Fridays and must be scheduled at least two days in advance.
